The COMMON project aims at applying the **Integrated Coastal Zone Management (ICZM)** principles to tackle marine litter in **5 pilot coastal areas**, through a local coordination and the Mediterranean networking among different stakeholders. promoting an effective participatory approach. **The purpose is to test a model transferable across the Mediterranean basin.**



Specific objectives:

Improving knowledge of litter sources and impacts, harmonizing protocols and methodologies

Institutional capacity building in tackling marine litter throughout ICZM plan

Building permanent stakeholders forums for partecipative ICZM plans

MONITORING ACTIVITIES



Three fold monitoring approach considering plastic detection plastic tracers detection, biomarkers detection.



- macro-and microplastics survey and sampling;
- microplastics polymer diagnosis (sources identification);
- evaluation of microplastics impact on species;
- assessment of ML sources;
- sampling and survey of sentinel species in the pilot areas.
