Background and Scope of Position

The YOUthCARE4planet project aims to support a new environmentally conscious generation in planning, acting, advocating and accessing decision making to drive sustainable change in Greece, Italy, Tunisia and Egypt. Within the framework of the [You\(th\)Care4Planet](#), the Mediterranean Information Office for Environment, Culture and Sustainable Development is seeking for a part-time Youth Engagement expert who will be responsible in the youth engagement component of the project. The Implementation of the [You\(th\)Care4Planet](#) Project began in 11th of September 2025 and has a total duration of 24 months (till 10/09/2027).

Job Profile

Primary responsibility will be to follow the [You\(th\)Care4Planet](#) Project activities that focus on youth's capacity building, networking and engagement in advocacy and actions for green transition. The main duties and responsibilities are:

- Following up the activities under WP3: Youth capacity building through dedicated e-learning course (developed by MIO-ECSDE) and several webinars, co-organised by the partners, in close cooperation with the You(th)Care4Planet Project Officer. Providing technical support in the organisation of the youth's capacity building on the topics of youth advocacy actions on ecological transition, promoting the youth participation and engagement aspect.
- Following up the activities under WP4: Technical support in the co-designing of 8 YouthCARE Green Local Action Plans (green LAPs) by the youth initiatives, in terms of participatory features, active engagement, inclusivity, interculturality/innovative approaches. Contribution in the coaching of the LAPs. Advice on applying participatory youth-led monitoring of the LAPs' impact.
- Overall support in the project coordination and in enhancing the participatory, inclusive, interculturality and educational components of the project's activities.
